Exhibitor number must be worn while showing or exhibitor will not be placed. Numbers and passes must be picked up at the secretary's office on Monday.

Age Classifications

Registration papers must be available to the superintendent of the department when checking ear markings, ear tags, tattoos or other markings of identification. No unreadable marks will be accepted.

Senior Bull Calf - calved after September 1, 2009.

Yearling Bull - calved between September 1, 2008 and August 31, 2009.

Senior Heifer Calf - calved after September 1, 2009.

Late Summer Yearling Heifer - calved between July 1 and August 30, 2009.

Early Summer Yearling Heifer - calved between May 1 and June 30, 2009.

Late Junior Yearling Heifer - calved between March 1 and April 30, 2009.

Early Junior Yearling Heifer - calved between January 1 and February 29, 2009.

Senior Yearling Heifer - calved after September 1, 2008.

1. An entry fee of \$10.00 per head will be charged for each entry in the Open Class; \$5.00 in Junior Classes.
2. Stall rent will be \$5.00 per head.
3. An exhibitor's season ticket, \$8.00, must be purchased by exhibitor. Only one helper's ticket will be allowed to exhibitors for every ten head entered and owned by one exhibitor. Do not ask for more.
4. The entry fee, stall fee, and exhibitor's season ticket fee must accompany entry. No stall reserved unless stall fee is sent with entry.
5. Cattle must be in place by 4:00 p.m. Monday, July 5 and will be released Thursday, July 8 at 4:00 p.m.
NO LATE ARRIVALS ACCEPTED.
6. The show order will follow the age classifications.
7. All cattle must have registration papers.
8. Steers and Market Heifers will be weighed on Tuesday, July 6. Weighing will begin at 4:00 p.m. or after the 4-H show.
9. Pair of Females - any age.
10. Pair of Calves - 1 bull and 1 female (senior bull and senior heifer calf).
11. Pair of yearlings - 1 bull and 1 female (junior or summer yearlings).

"The Section 17 FFA fair will be held on the Ford County Fairgrounds on Monday July 5. Space will be required for these entries on Monday morning. Tack area will be available after the FFA Show."
