3. All plant material must be well groomed. Soil, roots and spent leaves removed and exhibited in clean containers.
4. Potted Plants must have been in possession of exhibitor and have been growing in pot in which exhibited at least one month.
5. Specimen Cut Flowers must have been grown by exhibitor and must be in full bloom. Entries in this class will be judged on flower quality only and not on arrangement.
6. Specimen Cut Flowers must be exhibited in a clear or lightly tinted container.
7. All Artificial flowers and/or foliage excluded in Potted Plants and Specimen Cut Flowers.
8. Flowers and foliage in Bouquets and Arrangements will be judged as follows: arrangement 45%; color harmony 30%; flower quality 25%. Foliages and accessories are permitted in all bouquets and arrangements. For arrangements only-materials need not be grown by exhibitor.
9. It is suggested that deep enough containers be used to hold water for ease of handling.
10. All exhibitors are required to see that their entries are tagged and watered at the time of the entry. The department heads will not be responsible for failure to do so.
