3. An exhibitor's season ticket, \$8.00, must be purchased by exhibitor. Only one helper's ticket will be allowed to exhibitors for every ten head

entered and owned by one exhibitor. Do not ask for more. Passes must be picked up at the Secretary's office on Tuesday, July 6, 2010.

4. The entry fee, stall fee, and exhibitor's season ticket fee must accompany entry. No stall reserved unless stall fee is sent with entry.
5. Each exhibitor will be limited to two monies per class.
6. Barrows will be weighed between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 6, 2010. Barrows must be in place by 6:00 p.m. Tuesday.
7. Barrows must be negative to a serum neutralization (SN) test for pseudorabies. Refer to swine health requirements.
8. The barrows will be released Wednesday evening as soon as the Secretary's office can prepare premium money receipts. Be governed by announcement from Secretary's office.
9. There will be a limit of 255 head of barrows for this show. Entries will be accepted and closed, based on postmark date.
10. Ear notch identification of crossbred swine does not satisfy USDA identification requirements for brucellosis and pseudorabies testing.

PREMIUM SCHEDULE OF OPEN SWINE

All purebred barrows will show in specified purebred classes, with all crossbred barrows showing in crossbred classes. Classes will be divided equally based on the number entered. Purebred barrows must be registered to the individual showing, and papers must be present at time of weigh-in. There will be a minimum of eight barrows per class and a maximum of ten per class.

JACKPOT GILT SHOW

1. An entry fee of \$8.00 and pen fee of \$5.00 will be charged for each entry.
2. Exhibitors must purchase an exhibitor's season ticket at \$8.00 per exhibitor.
3. The entry fee and exhibitors season ticket fee must accompany entry.
4. Gilts must be in place by 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 6th and will be released after the show.
5. Check-in will begin at 8:00 a.m. and all gilts must be checked in by 11:00 a.m. with the show starting at approximately 1:00 p.m.
6. Gilts will be shown as breeding gilts.
7. Purebred will show by age, and must be registered in the person's name that is showing.
8. Crossbred gilts will be shown by weight.
9. All gilts must be farrowed after January 1, 2010.
10. Each breed must have at least eight head to have a breed class.
11. Maximum of ten head per class.
